

## Brokenhead Ojibway Nation (BON) 65+ Off Reserve Supplement

**Purpose:** Chief & Council have made a decision to assist BON membership financially for the purposes of providing a subsidy to offset additional living costs off reserve. Subject through available BON own source revenue funds for 65+ off-reserve and must meet the following criteria to qualify.

- Be 65+
- Living off reserve
- Living Independently

BON membership must meet the following to qualify.

Application: Must be completed at the age of 65+ (retroactive) payments will not be provided.

Eligibility: Must be registered to BON.

Documentation Require: Proof of BON registered membership.

Who Qualifies: Must be 65+ years of age.

What is the maximum amount: \$300.00 payable on the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month
