



Brokenhead Ojibway Nation (BON)

Traditional/Spiritual

Purpose: Chief & Council have made a decision to assist BON membership financially, subject through available BON own source revenue funds for traditional/spiritual

The pursuit of ceremonial/spiritual fulfillment is viewed as a positive pursuit that can serve to assist with both individual and community well-being. BON is supportive of such pursuits and recognizes that financial constraint may create challenges.

Eligibility: (must meet the following criteria to qualify)

- Must be registered BON Member applying
- Must be 18 years
- Must be the head of a church or traditional lodge that is situated within or on BON lands
- Supporting documentation may be required to confirm applicant information
- Must be registered in the BON traditional/spiritual group registry

Application: Must be completed

What is the maximum amount: \$1,400.00 (Annual April – March)

- Payable directly to the head of the church/lodge
